Built as part of the re-development of an old milk depot at 2c Kings Grove, Peckham, London SE15, the m2 Gallery is a window measuring one metre square by half a metre deep. Facing onto the street, it can be viewed 24 hours a day by anyone who wants to have a look.

## Current Exhibition

'Every Which Way' Jacqueline Poncelet. 16 May-27 June 2003

Until now, the m2 Gallery has presented a blind eye to the street. The gallery's first exhibition, Jacqueline Poncelet's 'Every Which Way', opens it up to reveal a spacious interior, literally expanded every which way in a fantastic array of real and reflected images.

The simple construct of glass panels delicately balanced on a timber framework becomes a complex maze within the metre square gallery space. 'Every Which Way' provides a tension between an invitation to enter and a sense of the havoc that this would cause were the viewer to take up the challenge. The combination of sandblasted mirror and glass creates an infinite world of intricately layered and interwoven patterns within a tiny space.
